**AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE COMPENSATION
OF THE WASHINGTON PARISH CLERK OF THE COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Section 2-10B of the Home Rule Charter for Washington Parish states: "The Council shall, by ordinance, fix the salary of the clerk. except that the salary shall not exceed the salary of a comparable position in the executive branch."

WHEREAS, by ordinance No. 08-474 the compensation of the Clerk of the Council was adjusted, effective on the 1st day of January, 2009, to equal the compensation of a comparable position in the executive branch, being the Secretary to the Parish President.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 08-474 further established that the compensation of the Clerk of Council shall be paid thereafter at the rate and in the method as may be approved by the Council.

BE IT ORDAINED, that the compensation of the Clerk of the Council shall be on a salary basis payable bi-monthly, effective October 1, 2010 and that employee benefits of the Clerk of the Council shall be the same as those of the Secretary to the Parish President.

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:




