**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING SLEEPY HOLLOW ROAD AS A  
PARISH ROAD UNDER POLICE POWERS OF HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE**

**WHEREAS**, under La. R.S. 33:1236 (2)(a) parish governing authorities have been granted the power "To regulate the proportion and direction, the making and repairing of the roads, bridges, causeways, dykes, dams, levees and highways when, in the opinion of the police jury, such work will further the best interests of the parish and the parish road system;"

**AND WHEREAS**, Section 1-05 of the Washington Parish Home Rule Charter declares "The Parish Government shall have the right, power, and authority to pass all ordinances requisite or necessary to promote, protect and preserve the general welfare, safety, health, peace and good order of the Parish...";

**AND WHEREAS**, there are a number of residents along Sleepy Hollow Road;

**AND WHEREAS**, the condition of Sleepy Hollow Road is such that the safety and welfare of the residents along the road are at risk due to difficulty in navigation of the road by school buses and emergency vehicles;

**BE IT ORDAINED**, under its police powers of Health, Safety and Welfare that the Washington Parish Government accepts Sleepy Hollow Road, more particularly described in COB 506, Page 249 & 250, Washington Parish, Louisiana, as a public road to be placed in the parish road maintenance system upon dedication of the road by the appropriate property owners in a manner acceptable to the Washington Parish Government and subject to Weyerhaeuser Company consenting to and dedicating to the parish that certain strip of land fifty feet wide by approximately 110 feet long in accordance with that certain Road Right of Way Agreement of record in COB 623, Page 481, Washington Parish, Louisiana.

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:




