

Washington Parish Council
Ordinance No. 08-471

Introduced on November 24, 2008
Introduced by Councilman Wheat
Public hearing held on December 8, 2008

An ordinance indicating the acknowledgement of approved funding for Washington Parish Government under Act 19 of the 2008 Regular Session of the State of Louisiana in the amounts of \$300,000 and also \$40,000 for the improvements of roads and bridges in the parish and to give the Parish President the authority to sign all contracts, forms, applications and other necessary documents to apply for and administer the appropriations.

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Government has been funded under Act 19 of the 2008 Regular Session, The General Appropriations Act, by the State of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the parish will receive allocations of \$300,000 and \$40,000 for the improvements of road and bridges in the parish.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Washington Parish Council that the parish will fund the labor and fringe benefits and the funding from the State will be used to purchase bridge and road materials.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Parish President be and is hereby authorized to sign all contracts, forms applications, reports, plans, notices and all other documents and paperwork necessary to apply for and administer the aforementioned grant program.




