An ordinance authorizing the Parish President
to call for bids and enter into a contract with the
successful bidder for construction of the
recreational area on the Pearl River Canal

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana has appropriated funds to Washington Parish
for the purpose of construction of recreation facilities at the Pearl River Canal; and

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED, that the Washington Parish Council does
hereby authorize the Parish President to call for bids on the construction of the
recreational facility at the Pearl River Canal; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED the Parish President be and is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract with the successful bidder of the aforementioned project and to
sign any and all documents necessary and incidental thereto.

ABSENT: 0 (None)


The ordinance was declared adopted on the 12th day of June 2006.


