**Item No. 12 – Resolution** - Councilman Nassauer offered a motion, seconded by Councilman Wheat to adopt a resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, on September 30, 2006, for the purpose of authorizing the continuation of the levy and collection of a special ad valorem tax of 4.6 mills on all property on all property subject to taxation within the boundaries of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, for a period of ten (10) years, commencing with the tax collection for the year 2007, and annually thereafter to and including the year 2016 for the purpose of improving, maintaining and operating the public library system of the Parish of Washington State of Louisiana and its branches, with the avails or proceeds of the tax to be administered by the Washington Parish Library Board; making application to the Louisiana State Bond Commission; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.
