An ordinance allowing Parish Disposal to exercise
the option to extend their contract for five (5) years

WHEREAS, the contract for solid waste collection between Parish Disposal, Inc.
and Washington Parish will expire October 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Section 10:00 of the contract provides the option of extending the
Contract for an additional five years, if mutually agreed upon by the Parish and Parish
Disposal, provided each party is advised no later than six (6) months prior to the ending
date of the original five (5) year term; and

WHEREAS, Harold Barber, President of Parish Disposal, has notified the Parish
Government of his desire to extend the original contract for an additional five (5) years as
provided by Section 10:00,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Washington Parish Council, that
Parish Disposal is allowed to exercise option of extending the Contract for waste
collection between Parish Disposal and Washington Parish for an additional five (5)
years.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Parish President be and is hereby
authorized to sign any and all necessary and incidental thereto.

The above having been submitted to a vote, the roll call vote resulted as follows:

ABSENT: 1 (Wheat)


The ordinance was declared adopted on the 27th day of March 2006.


