An ordinance indicating the intention of the Washington Parish Council to allocate funds for the procurement of professional services for the 2006-2007 FY LCDBG Program and to give the Parish President the authority to sign all contracts, forms, applications and other necessary documents to apply for and administer the grant

**WHEREAS**, the Washington Parish Government has decided to apply for a Louisiana Community Development Block Grant under the 2006-2007 program funding cycle; and

**WHEREAS**, the parish has agreed to allocate funds for Engineering and Administrative services in order to receive two "bonus" points on the LCDBG application,

**THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Washington Parish Council that the parish agrees to pay for engineering services in accordance with the contract with PEC Engineering and to pay for administrative services in accordance with the contract with Jim Ryan, LLC for services rendered in connection with the grant application.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Parish President be and is hereby authorized to sign all contracts, forms applications, reports, plans, notices and all other documents and paperwork necessary to apply for and administer the aforementioned grant program.



The ordinance was declared adopted on the 24th day of October 2005.


