An ordinance authorizing the Parish President to enter into a contract with Professional Engineering Consultants (PEC) for engineering services for the FY 2006-FY2007 LCDBG Program

**WHEREAS**, the Washington Parish Government intends to apply for funds under the FY 2006-FY2007 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant (LCDBG) as provided by Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parish desires to engage with an engineering firm to provide technical assistance for the Community Development Block Grant Program.

**THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Washington Parish Council, duly convened in regular session, that the Parish President is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Professional Engineering Consultants Corporation (PEC) for engineering services for the FY 2006- FY 2007 LCDBG Program and to use local funds for this purpose. The parish agrees to pay administrative fees for the grant for the Bogue Lusa Water Works District and for the second grant, if funded for road rehabilitation.


The foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the roll call vote resulted as follows:




