An ordinance making permanent Emergency

WHEREAS, the Parish President declared a state of emergency for Washington Parish; and

WHEREAS, the Parish Council adopted Emergency Ordinance No. 05-363 authorizing the Parish President to sign and enter into any contracts and to provide financial assistance for services addressing the needs that have impacted the citizens of Washington Parish.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the council does hereby make permanent Emergency Ordinance No. 05-363 adopted on August 30, 2005.

NAYS: 0 (None)




