ABSENT: 0 (None)





Councilman Miley offered a motion, seconded by Councilman Wheat to adopt Emergency Ordinance No. 05-363. A roll call vote resulted as follows:


YEAS: 4 (Sharp, Wheat, Miley and Brown)

An ordinance authorizing the Parish President to sign and enter into any contracts and to provide financial assistance for services addressing the need of the citizens of Washington Parish

WHEREAS, on August 29, 2005 Washington Parish suffered a direct hit from Hurricane Katrina; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane Katrina left total devastating destruction paralyzing the entire parish; and

WHEREAS, the simple basic needs for survival are now the greatest need; and

WHEREAS, additional needs will arise in a systematic order that will need addressing, and

WHEREAS, the parish will have to take the lead to secure and provide for the needs of the citizens and re-build our infrastructure;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Parish President be and is hereby authorized to sign and enter into any contracts and to provide financial assistance for said services in addressing the needs that have impacted the citizens of Washington Parish.

NAYS: 0


