An ordinance to amend the building permit  
fee requirement for agricultural purposes

WHEREAS, agriculture and dairy are leading industries in Washington Parish,  
and

WHEREAS, the agriculture and dairy industries have suffered economically  
during the past decade, and

WHEREAS, some farmers and dairymen are struggling to survive during these  
trying economic times, and

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Council does not wish to impose any  
additional financial hardship on the agriculture industry,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Washington Parish Council hereby  
amends the fee requirement for building permits that are related to the agriculture  
industry to a maximum fee of \$30.00.

NAYS: 0 (None)




