An ordinance authorizing the Parish President to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the State of Louisiana, Division of Administration, Office of State Lands, regarding the Pearl River Navigational Canal

WHEREAS, the U. S. Corps of Engineers, Vicksburg District, announced its intention to change the operation of the Pearl River Navigational Canal to unmanned status effective June 30, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Government desires to take the necessary steps to assure the Pearl River Navigational Canal remains open and accessible to the citizens of Washington Parish,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Parish President be and is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the State of Louisiana, Division of Administration, Office of State Lands for the purpose of operating and maintaining the boat ramps located in Washington Parish along the Pearl River Navigational Canal.

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:
