An ordinance authorizing the Parish President
to enter into a contract with the successful bidder
for construction of Cell 4 & 5 at the Choctaw Landfill

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Council did meet in regular session and duly convened that:

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Government has advertised for and received sealed bids for the construction of Cells 4 and 5 of the Choctaw Landfill,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the President of Washington Parish is hereby granted authority to enter into a contract with the successful bidder, Richard Price Construction Company; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Parish President is further authorized to sign any and all documents necessary and incidental to the construction of Cells 4 and 5 of the Choctaw Landfill.

ABSENT: 0 (None)


The ordinance was declared adopted on the 8th day of August 2005.


