Washington Parish Council Ordinance No. 04-343

Introduced on May 10, 2004 Introduced by Councilman Sumrall Public hearing held on May 24, 2004

> An ordinance to establish hours of operation for any race, speed contest or competition, drag races or acceleration contest, test of physical endurance, exhibition of speed or acceleration, or for the purpose of making a speed record and provide for penalties for violations thereof

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WASHINGTON PARISH COUNCIL THAT:

Section A. It shall be unlawful between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. for any person to operate any vehicle in any race, speed contest or competition, drag race or acceleration contest, test of physical endurance, exhibition of speed or acceleration or for the purpose of making a speed record, and no person shall in any manner participate in any such race, speed competition, drag race, test of physical endurance, exhibition, or purpose of making a speed record.

Section B. For purposes of this ordinance "participate" shall include engaging in, promoting or receiving money for admission of another person to a place where any event within Paragraph A occurs.

Section C. The prohibitions contained in this ordinance do no apply to events sanctioned by local governing authorities.

Section D. Any person convicted of violating this ordinance shall be fined \$100.00 for the first occurrence, \$300.00 for the second occurrence and \$500.00 for the third occurrence.
