An ordinance to abandon Boss Spears Road
(Washington Parish Road No. 7-41)

WHEREAS, Boss Spears Road is a dedicated road, used by the public and has been maintained by the Washington Parish Government for a number of years, and

WHEREAS, there is no longer need for Boss Spears Road to be used or maintained by the public,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Washington Parish Council that Boss Spears Road is hereby abandoned and shall be removed from the Washington Parish Road Inventory and that the Clerk of the Washington Parish Council shall file formal notice of the revocation of the dedication of Holiday Road into the official records of Washington Parish maintained by the Clerk of Court.

ABSENT: 0 (None)


The ordinance was declared adopted on the 10th day of May 2004.


