An ordinance to establish an effective
date for Ordinance No. 03-314 and
Ordinance No. 03-317

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2003, the Washington Parish Council duly adopted Ordinance No. 03-314 in order to comply with LA R.S. 18:532.1 requiring merger of precincts with less than 300 registered voters; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2002 the Washington Parish Council duly adopted Ordinance No. 03-317 establishing physical polling locations according to the mergers; and

WHEREAS, no date for implementation of these changes was specified in the ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Washington Parish has been notified that the changes in physical location of polling facilities will be implemented for the October 4, 2003 primary; and

WHEREAS, Washington Parish Officials do not believe that implementation can be possible in 60 days; and

WHEREAS, the parish has not yet received pre-clearance on one precinct that is being contested,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Washington Parish Council that the changes provided in Ordinance No. 03-314 adopted on March 24, 2003 and Ordinance No. 03-317 adopted on May 19, 2003 is made effective on November 17, 2003.


Having been submitted to a vote, the roll call vote resulted as follows:

NAYS: 0 (None)


ABSENT: 1 (Wheat)


