An ordinance authorizing the Parish President  
To enter into an agreement with Aegis Innovative  
Solutions, LLC to develop a Hazard Mitigation Plan  
For the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana

WHEREAS, Washington Parish must develop a DMA Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to receive future hazard mitigation funding through the Louisiana Office of Emergency Preparedness and the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the parish has received a grant through FEMA for preparation of said plan;  
and

WHEREAS, parish's share of the \$43,000 grant is \$10,750; and

WHEREAS, the parish's share will be \$5,300 in cash and approximately \$5,300 in in-kind services; and

WHEREAS, the municipalities within the parish will pay a pro rata share of the cost;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Washington Parish Council that the Parish President be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Aegis Innovative Solution, LLC to develop a Hazard Mitigation Plan for Washington Parish; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Parish President is authorized to sign any and all documents incidental thereto.


Having been submitted to a vote, the roll call vote resulted as follows:


