

The following ordinance having been introduced at a duly convened meeting on May 28, 2002, notice of the introduction having been duly published in the official journal and a public hearing having been held this date. was offered for final adoption by Clinton Miley and seconded by Charles Nassauer :

**ORDINANCE** NO. 02-286

An ordinance amending an ordinance adopted on May 13, 2002, providing for the levy of a thirty-three hundredths of one percent (.33%) sales and use tax in the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, Section 4.12 of an ordinance adopted by the Parish Council of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, on May 13, 2002 (the "Ordinance") provides for a dealer's compensation of two (2) percent rather than a one percent (1%) dealer's compensation; and

WHEREAS, this Council hereby desires to amend Section 4.12 of said Ordinance to provide for a one percent (1%) dealer's compensation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Parish council of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. Section 4.12 of the Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4.12. For the purpose of compensating the dealer in accounting for and remitting the Tax levied by this ordinance, each dealer shall be allowed one percent (1%) of the amount of Tax due and accounted for and remitted to the Collector in the form of a deduction in submitting his report and paying the amount due by him if the amount due was not delinquent at the time of payment."

SECTION 2. A certified copy of this ordinance shall be recorded as soon as possible in the Mortgage Records of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be published in full in one issue of the official journal of the Parish Council within thirty (30) days of the date of its adoption.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the President or the expiration of ten (10) days without the ordinance being signed or vetoed as set out in Section 2-13-B of the Home Rule Charter for Washington Parish, being an ordinance affecting the public peace, health and safety.


This ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:


