An Ordinance authorizing the Parish President to enter into a contract with Jim Ryan, LLC, for Administrative Services for the FY2002-FY2003 LCDBG Program

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Government intends to apply for funds under the FY2002 - FY2003 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant (LCDBG) as provided by Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and

WHEREAS, the Parish desires to engage with an engineering firm to provide technical assistance for the Community Development Program.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Washington Parish Council duly convened in regular session, that the Parish President is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jim Ryan, LLC for administrative services for the FY2002-FY2003 LCDBG Program, and to use local funds for this purpose. The parish agrees to pay \$33,700.00 for the first grant, to be used for improvements to Varnado Water Works District Washington Parish, Louisiana and an additional \$20,200.00, for the second grant, if funded, for road rehabilitation.


The foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the roll call vote resulted as follows:


