An ordinance authorizing the Parish President
to dispose of Surplus Property and Vehicles

BE IT ORDAINED by the Washington Parish Council, that the Parish President
be and is hereby authorized to dispose of surplus vehicles, trailers and a dump truck
frame, belonging to, but no longer used by the Washington Parish Government; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the surplus property, as per attached list, be
offered first to other governmental agencies or public entities of the Parish Government
and then advertised for bid in a manner as provided by law.


The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote resulted as




