An ordinance authorizing the Parish President
to enter into a Multi-Jurisdictional Consortium
Agreement for carrying out programs and
activities as authorized by the Workforce
Investment Act of 1998

WHEREAS, Public Law 105-220, which is the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, which authorizes the establishment of a consortium or multi-jurisdictional agreement for carrying out program and activities;

WHEREAS, said agreement will be between Ascension Parish Council, East Feliciana Parish Police Jury, Iberville Parish Police Jury, Livingston Parish Council, Point Coupee Police Jury, St. Helena Police Jury, Tangipahoa Parish Council, Washington Parish Council, West Baton Rouge Council and West Feliciana Police Jury with Gordon A. Burgess, President of the Tangipahoa Parish Council serving as authorized representative of all the units of government.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Parish President be and is hereby authorized to enter into a Multi-Jurisdictional Consortium Agreement with the aforementioned parishes.
