AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT BUDGET ADJUSTMENT NUMBER ONE (1) TO THE
2000 ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE WASHINGTON PARISH GOVERNMENT.

WASHINGTON PARISH GOVERNMENT DOES HEREBY ORDAIN

SECTION I: That the 2000 annual Operating Budget for fiscal year beginning January 1, 2000 and ending December 31, 2000 for the Washington Parish Government is hereby amended (budget adjustment 1) and made a part hereof (Addendum A) .Copies for public inspection are available in the Clerk of the Council's office.

SECTION II: Amounts amended are only to the extent of the amounts included in (Addendum A).

SECTION III: The Parish Council shall by ordinance adopt the amendments to the budget for fiscal year 2000. The council may make emergency appropriations by emergency ordinance in accordance with the provisions of the charter the amendments to cover the emergency ordinance to repair the elevator in the Courthouse are also included in budget adjustment number one (1).

SECTION IV: The remainder of the appropriations are to cover the sales tax election expense for roads and also the transfers to cover mandates from the Sales Tax Fund according tto the tax proposition.

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:
