AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
AND AUTHORIZING THE REPAIR OF THE ELEVATOR
AT THE WASHINGTON PARISH COURTHOUSE

WHEREAS, over the past few months, the elevator at the Washington Parish Courthouse has been in need of repair, and

WHEREAS, efforts to repair the hydraulic valves have failed, making it necessary to replace the entire hydraulic system; and

WHEREAS, replacement of the hydraulic system will cost \$8,618.00, and

WHEREAS, no funds were appropriated for maintenance

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Washington Parish Council declare an emergency situation which renders the Washington Parish Courthouse inaccessible to handicap citizens therefore affecting life, health and public safety, and


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Parish President be and is hereby authorized to have the hydraulic system replaced in the elevator at the Washington Parish Courthouse.


