**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOWEST QUALIFIED BID
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW CELL NO. 7
AT THE CHOCTAW ROAD LANDFILL
PROJECT NO. 168-19-0016
AND TO AUTHORIZE THE PARISH PRESIDENT
TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT, ANY AND ALL OTHER CONTRACTS
DECLARATIONS, APPLICATIONS, AMENDMENTS, AGREEMENTS AND ALL
OTHER DOCUMENTS RELATED THERETO
ON BEHALF OF THE WASHINGTON PARISH GOVERNMENT**

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Government advertised for bids for the construction of new cell No. 7 at the Choctaw Road Landfill Facility; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on July 19, 2019, with the lowest qualified bid being the sum of \$1,625,605.62 received from Creel Brothers, Inc. Franklin, Louisiana, having a Louisiana Contractor's License No. 3925; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that in addition to the execution of the contract with the lowest qualified bidder, that additional contracts and other agreements will be necessary with a Quality Assurance Quality Control (QAQC) manager, soil testing services providers and other service providers in order to fulfill the project requirements.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Washington Parish Council accept the low bid of \$1,625,605.62 by Creel Brothers, Inc., on the construction of new cell No. 7 at the Choctaw Road Landfill Project No. 168-19-0016.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Parish President is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest qualified bidder, along with all other contracts, declaration, applications, amendments, agreements and all other documents necessary to administer the project, including, but not limited to, contracts and agreements with a QAQC manager and soil testing services providers on behalf of the Washington Parish Government.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the signature of the Washington Parish President.

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:


