**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE
WASHINGTON PARISH LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION
AMEND LOUISIANA REVISED
STATUTE 33:103 RELATIVE TO
PLANNING COMMISSION COMPENSATION**

WHEREAS, in December 2005, the Washington Parish Government created the Washington Parish Planning Commission; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Washington Parish Legislative Delegation is hereby requested to introduce legislation to amend Louisiana Revised Statute 33:103 by adding paragraph N with wording similar to the following,

To-Wit:

N. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, the governing authority of the parish of Washington may pay members of the planning and zoning commission of the parish a per diem not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than sixty dollars for attendance at meetings of the commission for a maximum of twenty-four meetings per year. Any such per diem shall be paid by the parish governing authority from monies appropriated out of the general fund of the parish.

This amendment shall become effective as of the date signed by the governor.

Having been submitted to a vote, the vote resulted as follows:


