RESOLUTION No. 20-1005

A resolution approving the holding of an election in Fire Protection District No. 8 of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of bonds therein.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 8 of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of Fire Protection District No. 8 of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana (the "District"), adopted a resolution on April 6, 2020, calling a special election in the District on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of bonds therein; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the District has requested that this Parish Council, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to issue, sell and deliver the bonds provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Parish Council to approve the holding of said election and in the event that the election carries, to issue, sell and deliver the bonds provided for therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 8 of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana, this Parish Council hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, at which election there will be submitted the following proposition, to-wit:

BOND PROPOSITION

Shall Fire Protection District No. 8 of the Parish of Washington, State of Louisiana (the "District"), incur debt and issue bonds to the amount of not exceeding Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000), to run not exceeding fifteen (15) years from date thereof, with interest at a rate not exceeding six per centum (6%) per annum, to be sold at par, premium or discount, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving buildings, machinery and equipment, including fire stations, to be used in giving fire protection to the property in the District, title to which shall be in the public; which bonds will be general obligations of the District and will be payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the manner provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental thereto, with an estimated 6.75 mills to be levied in the first year of issue to pay said Bonds?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, this Parish Council does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to issue, sell and deliver the bonds provided for therein.

This resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
