As of Wednesday, July 8, 2020, the Louisiana Department of Health is reporting COVID-19 cases for Washington Parish:

765 Cases reported
48 Deaths reported
730 State tests complete
8139 Commercial tests complete

Considering the rise in positive cases and hospitalizations and to help prevent the state regressing to pre-phase 1 restrictions, I ask that the citizens of our parish continue to do their due diligence to protect themselves by practicing the following:

Wash your hands frequently

Cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze

Wear some type of facial covering in public

Practice social distancing which means keeping 6 feet distance between yourself and others


Avoid congregate settings whenever possible
