**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF EXPANDING
LOUISIANA HIGHWAY 25 AND MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 27
TO FOUR LANES**

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Council acknowledges the importance of expanding Louisiana Highway 25 and Mississippi Highway 27 to four lanes in providing a north/south emergency evacuation corridor as well as economic development for the southern region of the United States from New Orleans to Memphis, Tennessee.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Washington Parish Council continues to support the expansion of Louisiana Highway 25 and Mississippi Highway 27 to four lanes and respectfully requests an update of the Regional Planning Commission Louisiana Highway 25 feasibility study dated June 11, 2010 and supports all future efforts to make the expansion of Louisiana Highway 25 and Mississippi Highway 27 into four lanes a reality.

The above and foregoing having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereupon resulted as follows:




