**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT
(ARPA) FUNDS FOR THE EXTENSION OF BROADBAND SERVICES IN
WASHINGTON PARISH**

WHEREAS, Washington Parish is in need of broadband service throughout the entire Parish; and

WHEREAS, there are funds available to Washington Parish for investment in broadband infrastructure through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and

WHEREAS, the Washington Parish Council and the Washington Parish Government desire to invest in the educational and economic future of our Parish through providing broadband service to unserved areas of Washington Parish.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Washington Parish Council and the Washington Parish Government do hereby allocate Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to be disbursed for the extension of broadband services in Washington Parish.


